I'm Jeffery. Even though some things are difficult, let's try together. You can learn new things when you take the risk to try. Let's do it!




My name is Quentin. If you give up, I will visit you in your dreams. Ha, ha, ha! Remember, mistakes help you improve so never give up.

Talking with Principal Lo: F: Faye Evie

- F+J: Good morning Principal Lo. Thank you for joining us in this interview. Please would you introduce yourself, and explain what has your experience of being a principal at a new school been like?
- P. Lo: Nice to meet you, Jessie and Faye. First of all, thank you for interviewing me. This is my second year of working in the school. It is my honour to be your principal and work with the whole school team with love and collaboration. Actually, I was an English teacher. I have taught English for many years! I really love kids. From all of you, I can feel your confidence and your readiness to learn. This is one of the reasons why I love my job.

- J: There are many challenges when starting new things and not everything is smooth sailing. Do you think believing in yourself is very important when you start new things? Why?
- P. Lo: Well, I think before we do anything, we have to believe in ourselves. From my experience, all things are difficult before they are easy. We can tackle any problems as long as we have confidence. Self-confidence is the key to success. We have to be confident before we get things done or try to attempt things. I also think perseverance is important too.

- F: If a student gets low marks in their exam, what would you say to comfort them?

We should be positive and prepare well for each challenge and accept that the test score only shows where you are right now. It is not reflective of where you will end up. The key is to always have perseverance and always be confident and be prepared. If we are persistent, we can achieve high marks or definitely improve.

- J: How can having a growth mindset help students?
- P. Lo: Having a growth mindset can allow students to value and enjoy what they are doing regardless of the outcome. Students with a growth mindset love challenges, and know that they can learn from mistakes. Furthermore, students with a positive mindset keep learning despite difficulties or challenging tasks. Having a growth mindset can give us the confidence to learn anything throughout our lives.

To celebrate the 100th day at school and becoming a better learner in growth mindset, some interesting learning activities were organised for P1 students in the English DTS programme.









our Primary 1 school life.




